High School Life Camp is a camp designed to train Christian high school students ('16-'17 school year) to be stronger and more effective in their faith. It builds on the work of Junior Life Camp, and seeks to go even deeper into spiritual discussions, preparing Christian young people to live as adults who follow Jesus.

Camp will be a week of fun and intense spiritual training with counselors and staff who are passionate about helping students grow closer to their Lord, and preparing them to take a stand for Him. The camp is small, which makes for an ideal setting to build relationships with peers and to learn about Christian

Our name stands for **Living In Faith Effectively**. We feel there is a need for an effective living out of our faith (James 2:16-26). We want to be an encouragement to children not to conform to the world, but by faith, to live a dynamic, distinctive Christian life (Romans 12:1-2).

We will study how we are to be vessels of honor for God (2 Timothy 2), dedicated our whole lives to His service. Daily activities include a memory verse, morning devotions, biography hour, a Bible lesson, a missionary lesson, evening chapel and cabin devotions.

In addition to many activities geared toward spiritual growth, there will be many fun activities and opportunities to build meaningful friendships. Fun activities include swimming times for the boys and for the girls, games on the field and exploring the creek. Campers will also have a chance to share a talent or to take part in a skit in our annual Talent Show.

We ask that a parent or guardian fill out the camper application/medical release and return it to Life Camp along with a non-refundable deposit of \$30 to reserve your place. The balance is due July 30. The cost will be \$245 for the first child and \$235 for each additional child. Applications received by June 30th receive a \$20 discount per camper. Some scholarships are available. Children may also participate in a fund raiser to raise their own camp fees.

Please detach the reference letter and give it to a pastor or elder at your church to be filled out and returned to us directly. Upon acceptance of your child, we will send you a packet including a list of what to bring, the daily schedule, and directions to Lopez Canyon Conference Center.

Dear Fellow Christian worker:

We at LIFE Camp strive to create an environment conducive to spiritual growth among Christian youth. We appreciate your willingness to give us some background information on this applicant.
